Suggestions and Tips for Host Families

1. Food and housing are to be provided by the host family. In most cases this will be breakfast, some lunches and evening meals. Many lunches and evening meals will be provided in conjunction with scheduled Rotary activities.
2. Please give thoughts to your guests' personal needs, such as laundry, cleaning etc.
3. All personal expenses of the team members will be the responsibility of each team member.
4. Rotary Foundation rules do not allow our guests to drive a car or fly in private aircraft while in District 6060.
5. A common error is to over schedule activities. It is important to allow time for "in-depth" exposure to each experience with ample time for questions and answers.
6. The team members are between 25 and 40 years old. Try to provide them an opportunity to interact with people of this age group.
7. Team members need time to write letters, keep up with their diaries, etc. Allow them time for these activities. Weekends should not be overdone.
8. It is essential that they arrive at scheduled group activities on time.
9. Normal family life, with your guest as a member of the family, is often the best "quality time" that you and the team members will experience. The team members will appreciate sharing the normal activities of your family and the opportunity for open discussions of local, state and national affairs.
